Cultural Education Market Fair:

PCEP's Agora is the Cultural Education central public space and venue for our partner Higher Education Institutions, DepEd local schools (SPA), LGUs, National Association of Cultural Educators and Scholars (NACES) to showcase their talents, researches, products, local cultural icons, and their people in one creative market place. In our history, AGORA, in ancient Greek cities, is an open space that served as a meeting ground for various activities of their citizens. The 2024 AGORA Project of NCCA-PCEP shall be held in Bulacan with preparatory promotions during the NBDB National Book Festival at World Trade Center (April 25-28, 2024). Several performances and training shall be conducted during the said event.

In Bulacan, the NCCA-PCEP's AGORA or the marketplace, shall be the ROBINSON's Place Malolos, where many locals and tourists visited the place for business, recreation, meeting people, socialization, celebrations and shopping personal needs, watching and appreciating contemporary arts & culture happens.

- 5. Programs of NCCA-PCEP, NACES and other partner Institutions can also promote their artistic-products and cultural programs in the market.

Participation Guidelines

- 1. Interested participants are required to register online
- 2. The program is open on a "first-to-apply, first-priority" basis.
- 3. Arrangements and costs of transportation, accommodation, and all meals are the responsibility of the participants and may be charged to local funds.
- 4. The PCEP Secretariat will notify participants of slot confirmation via email. Confirmed participants will receive final travel instructions to the training venue and other participation requirements.
- 5. Online registration is free but comes with an obligation. The number of participants is limited, and your registration may result in other attendees missing a slot if the maximum capacity is reached. If you cannot attend the program for which you have already registered, we kindly ask that you let us know. Cancellations must be made at least two weeks before the scheduled seminar.
- 6. The NCCA-PCEP reserves the right not to accept walk-in applicants/participants.
- 7. The NCCA-PCEP reserves the right not to issue any Certificate of Appearance or Certificate of Participation to participants who do not finish the seminar-workshop as scheduled.

A. TOURISM STAKEHOLDERS & EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS:

Mounting of 2x2 booths at the main hall of the Mall.

Local Tourism offices shall be encouraged to participate. They will mount their own booth at the Mall. Local products such as local crafts, native to the community and popular local intangible arts can be displayed, sell (subject to approval of the mall) and performed.

Universities in Luzon shall also be invited to participate in the event. Their publications, information about the courses offered, amenities, activities, uniqueness, school values can be showcased.

PCEP shall recognize the Best Booth on the last day of the Event.

B. STUDENT-ARTISTS Showcase:

Showcase of Theater-Dance Production about Local cultural products, icons or festivals. All interested school-based participants should comply with all the needed requirements. Open to all Public and Private schools (amateur or professional).



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Music to be used by participating schools must be original and highlighting the rich culture of their city or municipality. NOT commercially released (free from copyrights).

The theater-dance production must not exceed ten (10) minutes, inclusive of intro and outro. Words with registered trademarks/brand names, explicit and offensive lyrics are strictly prohibited. Music in MP3 must be submitted to https://bit.ly/3WQN3N8 or scan QR Code on or before August 2, 2024. Music shall be considered final once submitted and cannot be modified or altered.

The Performance is on September 28, 2024 - 10AM in Bulacan.

PCEP will give prizes to Top 3- best performers. All entries shall be judged according to the set criteria. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and unappealable.

Winners will be awarded the following cash prize: Grand Winner – Php 15,000.00 / 1st Runner-Up – Php 10,000.00 / 2nd Runner-Up – Php 5,000.00

Guidelines for joining

- 1. DULARAWAN 3 is open to all interested community-based and school-based theater groups. It is open to theater groups of all ages and experience levels.
- 2. Theater groups must complete and submit their entries online using the provided submission link https://forms.gle/JnkuVARiJNeKn6Nc6
- 3. Participation in DULARAWAN 3 requires the submission of:
 - a. Twenty (20) minutes video-mp4 format, including intro and outro
 - b. A clear copy of the script
 - c. A list of production members, including:
 - Actors
 - Director
 - Technical crew
- 4. Entry must be minimalist (symbolic representation) set, original piece of the group, and free from copyright issues.
- 5. Once submitted, an entry is considered final and cannot be altered or modified in any form.
- 6. Deadline for submission of entries is August 2, 2024.
- 7. Actual stage performance is slated on September 29, 2024.

Top-Three (3) performance entries shall be selected on the same date and shall be awarded the following cash:

GRAND WINNER - Php 15,000.00 FIRST RUNNER UP - Php 10,000.00



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SECOND RUNNER UP - Php 5,000.00
