- 3. To reiterate paragraph 2 of RM 125, please note that the Scholarship grant is designed to be a two-summer training, which aims to provide the regular teachers with the knowledge and skills on various educational programs and interventions appropriate to learners with special educational needs.
- 4. Expenses for this scholarship shall be charged against the Basic Education Curriculum Funds (BEC). Transportation expenses to and from the venue amounting to three thousand pesos each (PhP 3,000.00) have been downloaded to the Regional Office. The same amount will be downloaded to your SDOs for the transportation of the participating teacher in your Division. Tuition fees shall be directly paid to the serving institution by the Central Office. Book allowances and stipend shall be given to the participants at the venue. Participants may stay in the University dormitory or outside depending on their convenience and at their own expense while waiting for the stipend.
- 5. After each phase of the program, each participating teacher is required to submit a narrative report to the Regional Office addressed to the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (Attention: Regional SPED Coordinator) or may be emailed to <code>clmd.depedcar@gmail.com</code>. Format must include the following: Title of the Activity, Duration and Venue, Insights gained, and Next steps (what to do with the insights gained).
