

- 6. Top 5 Winners from the National Schools Press Conference shall be given cash incentives based on the following:
 - a. Individual Writing Contests: first-₱2,500; second-₱2,000; third-₱1,500; fourth-₱1,000; fifth-₱700 (for both coaches and students)
 - b. Group Writing Contests (Radio Broadcasting and Collaborative Desktop Publishing): first-\$\pi^7,000\$ for students and \$\pi^3,000\$ for coach; second-\$\pi^5,500\$ for students and \$\pi^2,500\$ for coach; third-\$\pi^4,000\$ for students and \$\pi^2,000\$ for coach; fourth-\$\pi^2,500\$ for students and \$\pi^1,500\$ for coach; fifth-\$\pi^2,000\$ for students and \$\pi^1,000\$ for coach
