



The International AIDS Candlelight Memorial (IACM) is an annual commemoration on the third Sunday of May to remember those people who have died of AIDS and, honor the memories of those who have lost their lives to HIV and AIDS, and support those who are living with the virus.


This year, the 2024 IACM will be emphasizing the importance of prioritizing the needs and rights of people living with and affected by HIV with the theme: "PUT TOGETHER FIRST: Kandila ng Pagkalinga, Liwanag ng Pag-asa." It also calls for collective action to empower individuals and communities to fight against stigma and discrimination and to advocate for equitable access to services - HIV prevention, referral, treatment, care, and support services.

In line with this, the Office of Undersecretary for Operations, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), encourages all DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel, student leaders, and field offices to commemorate the IACM on **May 20-25**, **2024** through the following:

- 1. posting of the event banner;
- 2. sharing of social media content regarding HIV/AIDS from the DepEd Tayo and DepEd Philippines Facebook Page:
- 3. distribution of educational materials:
- -. creating informational posters to display around the school;
- 5. writing letters and or posting messages of support for people living with HIV/AIDS (PLHIV) on social media;
- 6. conducting of HIV/AIDS awareness seminars/symposiums;
- 7. red ribbon campaign: distribution of red ribbons, the universal symbol of HIV/AIDS awareness; and











8. other related candlelight memorial activity.
