




All *OKD Coordinators* are enjoined to help promote the Awards to all schools in their respective jurisdictions and provide necessary assistance, as practicable, to public schools that have expressed interest in joining the Awards. However, it is reiterated that **"no voluntary or mandatory tasks or activities shall be assigned to teachers from June 1 to 30, 2024,"** pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024**, titled *Amendment to DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024)*. *OKD Coordinators* are also enjoined to coordinate directly with their respective DOH counterparts for any new updates about the Awards, including any further extension of the deadline, if any. Schools may also follow the DOH Facebook Page for official announcements.

It is emphasized that the **OUOPS Memorandum No. DM-OUOPS-2024-08-03465** is sufficient basis for DepEd schools to participate in the Awards. The Awards is among the initiatives coordinated by the DOH with DepEd, as committed under the **DOH-DSWD-DepEd-CHED-LEB-TESDA-DILG Joint Administrative Order (JAO) No. 2022-0001** or the *"Guidelines on Healthy Settings Framework in Learning Institutions"*.
