

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. **264.2023**

GRANT OF AUTOMATIC TWO-MONTH MORATORIUM ON PAYMENT OF PROVIDENT FUND LOAN (PF) AMORTIZATIONS

- 1. The Provident Fund National Board of Trustees has approved Board Resolution No. 5, s. 2023 entitled "Resolution Approving the Grant of an Automatic Two-Month Moratorium on Payment of Provident Fund Loan Amortizations of Borrowers Affected by Calamity". Subsequently, Memorandum OUF-2023-0494 was issued by Undersecretary Annalyn M. Sevilla on the implementation of the said Board Resolution.
- 2. The guidelines for the grant of the automatic loan moratorium of two (2) months for loan borrowers affected by calamity are as follows:
 - a. There is a declaration of state of calamity officially issued by either the President of the Philippines, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and its counterpart agencies in the Regions, Provinces, Cities and Municipalities, or by the Legislative Councils of Local Government Units concerned;
 - b. The two-month moratorium **SHALL APPLY TO ALL PF BORROWERS** who are teaching and non-teaching personnel and **actually working and/or residing** in region/s, province/s, city/ies or school division/s covered by the declaration of a state of calamity;
 - c. Existing PF deductions to be temporarily stopped shall be lodged at the "Undeducted Obligations" of the payslip of the borrower, and shall automatically be restored to the payroll after the two-month period is implemented;
 - d. Loan term in the payroll program shall be adjusted/extended corresponding to the 2 months of loan amortization;
 - e. No additional interest shall be imposed on the loan accounts during the moratorium period;

- f. The loan moratorium shall take effect immediately in the next payroll month after the declaration of the state of calamity;
- g. All payroll units in the region/schools division/implementing unitssecondary schools shall be directed to implement the loan moratorium; and,
- h. All PF Chapters are directed to report on loan moratorium granted to PF borrowers not later than two weeks after the end of the grant of loan moratorium.
- 3. It shall be the responsibility of the Schools Division Offices concerned to inform the Regional Office, and to provide the document showing the declaration of state of calamity officially issued by the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and its counterpart agencies in the Regions, Provinces, Cities and Municipalities, or by the Legislative Councils of Local Government Units;
- 4. The Schools Division Office shall submit to the Regional Office a consolidated report on the Grant of the Two-Month Moratorium by the Implementing Units-Secondary Schools and by the Schools Division Offices in cases of personnel being paid at the Division Office. This report is to be submitted by the Division Office to the Regional Office as soon as the moratorium has been effected on the payrolls. Attached is the template for the report;
- 5. The report/s from the field shall be included in the consolidated Regional Report to be submitted by the Regional Director, as the Chairperson of the PF Regional Board of Trustees, to the PF National Board of Trustees;
