

CALL FOR SUBMISSION OF DIVISION NOMINEES TO THE REGIONAL SCREENING OF GAWAD MATATAG ALS CLC CATEGORY


- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 030, s. 2024 titled "2024 National Literacy Awards (NLA) Gawad MATATAG," the Regional Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Regional Screening of Division Nominees for the Gawad MATATAG, specifically for Alternative Learning System (ALS) Community Learning Centers (CLCs) on September 17-18, 2024.
- 2. The Gawad MATATAG aims to recognize and celebrate outstanding public schools and **CLCs** in improving learning outcomes, reward commendable implementation of the MATATAG Education Agenda; and promote and strengthen functional literacy, health, values, and peace education.
- 3. Below are the parameters to consider in determining the nominees from each division:
 - Offers the three Major ALS Programs- Basic Literacy Programs (BLP), Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Programs: Elementary and Junior High School.
 - Minimum of Type 3 CLC- A typical learning center or school classroom, permanent and secured, mostly made of cement and other heavy building materials and equipped with basic furniture and learning equipment.
 - **Enrolment Rate** The Division Officed shall look at the enrolment rate of the CLC for the past 3 years. This is to determine that the nominated CLC is consistent in serving the same or greater number of ALS learners each year.
 - **Passing Rate-** The Division Offices shall look at the passing rate of the CLC for the past 3 years. This is to determine that the nominated CLC has a consistent record of ALS learners passing the PPA.



- **Transition Rate** The Division Offices shall look at the transition rate of the CLC for the past 3 years. This is to determine that the nominated CLC has a consistent record of ALS learners progressing to the next level of education.
- 4. The nomination form, checklist for validation and MOVs shall be prepared and submitted in soft copies to the Regional Office through <u>car.clmd@deped.gov.ph</u> on or before September 16, 2024.
- 5. Attached are the Nomination Form, Criteria for Evaluation and Checklist for Validation for reference.
- 6. The winner from the Regional Screening will be automatically sent to the Bureau of Alternative Education Gawad MATATAG Screening Committee on September 21, 2024.
