## ENHANCING GOOD MANNERS & RIGHT CONDUCT AND VALUES EDUCATION THROUGH BOY AND GIRL SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES ACTIVITIES

- 1. The Department of Education Cordillera Administrative Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division aims to enhance Good Manners and Right Conduct (GMRC) and Values Education (VE) through BSP & GSP activities *every last Friday of the month* aligned to Republic Act no. 11476, December 04, 2021 "An Act Institutionalizing GMRC and VE in the K to 12 Curriculum Appropriating Funds Therefor, and for other Purposes", specifically Rule II of Sec. 7 which stipulates the "Institutionalization of GMRC and VE in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum".
- 2. The GMRC & Values Education (VE) and Scouting programs are deeply intertwined in their goals and aspirations to shape the Filipino youth. Both programs aim to develop well-rounded individuals committed to the common good. GMRC & VE focus on cultivating responsible decision-making, moral conduct, and a love for God, self, family, fellow citizens, nature, country, and the world. Similarly, Scouting complements these objectives by developing academic skills, self-confidence, ethics, leadership, and citizenship, equipping the youth with the values and skills that will guide them into responsible and productive adulthood. Together, these programs work toward forming principled, capable, and service-oriented citizens.
- 3. To support the goals of GMRC & VE and Scouting in developing good manners & right conduct and values among the youth, the following specific objectives are set:
  - a. to shape learners into responsible and responsive citizens of the country.
  - b. to develop productive skills through leadership programs and projects that contribute to values development and character formation.
  - c. to cultivate a heightened sense of social responsibility among learners.
- 4. Meanwhile, to undertake the implementation the suggested activities are as follows:
  - a. Integration of scouting values during GMRC/VE class
  - b. Team building related to GMRC/VE competencies and Scouting goals
  - c. Scheduling Spiritual Wellness (Eucharistic Celebration, Ecumenical Prayer, Meditations & the like)
