

Mass Training-Workshop of ALS Administrators/Managers/Implementers on the Utilization of ALS Enhanced Curriculum Aligned to K-12 and ALS Infed Support Materials

- 1. The Regional Office through the Curriculum Management & Learning Division will conduct an Orientation and Mass Training for ALS implementers on the Utilization of Enhanced Alternative Learning System (ALS) Curriculum aligned to K-12 and contextualization of Infed learning support materials on February 8-10, 2018 at NEAP-R, DepEd-CAR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 2. The Mass Training for ALS Implementers aims to:
  - ♦ Address the gap between the Old ALS Curriculum and the new enhanced ALS Curriculum aligned to K 12;
  - Contextualize and localize ALS Infed support learning materials
  - Ensure that the teaching and learning practices of ALS implementers will be standardized by providing them with the necessary knowledge, skills, attitudes and values;
  - Update participants on the new trends of ALS programs and projects implementation;
  - Enhance their potentials and capabilities for an effective and efficient performance of their roles and responsibilities as ALS advocates; and
  - Develop team work and spirit of partnership and a sense of ownership of the ALS program implementation.
