

- 1. With reference to DepEd Memorandum No. 220, s. 2016 entitled Developmentally Appropriate Practices in the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Training Program, DepEd-CAR will conduct the Regional Training on Developmentally-Appropriate Practices in ELLN on April 17 to 23, 2017 for Cluster 1 and on April 25 to May 1, 2017 for Cluster 2 at a venue to be informed later in a subsequent memorandum.
- 2. The purpose of the Training Program is to develop in Filipino children literacy and numeracy skills and attitudes, which will contribute to lifelong learning.
- 3. Participants will come from 40% of the teachers, school heads, and supervisors trained during the first ELLN regional and division trainings. Cluster 1 will be composed of participants from the Divisions of Abra, Baguio City, Benguet, and Mountain Province. Cluster 2 will be composed of participants from the Divisions of Apayao, Ifugao, Kalinga, and Tabuk City.

- 10. School heads of teacher participants are encouraged to take appropriate actions to avoid disruption of classes. School heads must make arrangements with available teachers in the school to take charge of classes of teachers who will be attending the training.
