# ADDENDUM and CORRIGENDUM to RM No. 45, s. 2019 (2019 Cordillera Administrative Region Athletic Association (CARAA) Meet)

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Division Sports Coordinators
All Others Concerned

- Based on the Minutes of Meeting during the 2019 First Regular Meeting of the CARAA Board and the Planning Conference for Regional Sports Program with the Provincial Local Government Unit of Apayao held last January 10 - 11, 2019, the following shall be observed during the conduct of the CARAA 2019:
  - a. To maintain credibility and effective delivery of functions, officiating officials or technical officials assigned to the different sporting events should not have multiple functions or should not have any designation in their respective divisions such as coach, co-coach, chaperon, team manager, trainer, consultant, working committee member, and the like.
  - b. Participating Divisions shall bring with them 2 delegation banners. 1 for the parade and 1 to be tied to the flagpoles, ready for hoisting during the opening program.
  - c. On February 27, 2019, assembly time for the Parade/Grand Entrance is 7:00 A.M. along Turod-San Gregorio Tourism Road, Luna, Apayao. The Parade/Grand Entrance shall commence at exactly 7:30 A.M.
  - d. NO "SALUDO" of delegations during the parade or grand entrance. Delegates are to just wave their caps while yelling their chants in continuous motion upon approaching the grandstand. Only the Apayao delegation (last delegation to enter the sports complex) shall stop in front of the grand stand to lead the *Unity Dance*.
  - e. The unity dance shall be done by all delegates, hence, a video recording of the dance steps as well as the song to be used (Galing ng Pinoy, 2017 Palarong Pambansa theme song written and performed by Dante M. Beriong) will be sent to all divisions for reference.
  - f. All delegates are likewise encouraged to attend the closing and awarding ceremonies.

- 2. For the safety and security of all participants to this regional event, the following measures shall be adopted:
  - a. Curfew is set at 11 P.M. Delegation officials, coaches, chaperons, trainers, and athletes must be in their respective billeting centers/schools on or before said time. Delegations may impose their own curfew time but must not go beyond 11 P.M.
  - b. All participants must wear their delegation IDs at all times even outside their playing venues or billeting centers/schools.
  - c. As practiced in every conduct of CARAA, delegations may also coordinate with their own PNP Provincial Office or City Police Office for additional security personnel who will escort them while traveling to Apayao as well as secure their billeting centers/schools.
- 3. Winners in the indigenous games shall also receive cash prizes pegged as follows:
  - a. Kadang Kadang (Walking Stilts): 1st- P4,000; 2nd- P3,000; 3rd- P1,000
  - b. Sanggol (Arm Wrestling): 1st P2,000; 2nd- P1,500; 3rd- 1,000
- 4. The scheduled final inspection of playing venues and billeting centers on February 14-15, 2019 shall not push through, however, Schools Division Offices may field their own technical committee to inspect and prepare their respective billeting centers. SDOs are advised to coordinate with their billeting center's school head/coordinator. (see Enclosure 3 of RM No. 45, s. 2019)
- 5. To strengthen established emergency medical protocols, a convergence (Medics Night) of all emergency medical service providers from all participating divisions shall be convened by the Apayao Provincial Health Office on February 25, 2019 at a venue and time to be announced later.
- 6. It is also advised that participants should bring with them insect repellant lotions and mosquito nets and for SDOs to ensure through their respective medical service providers that all of their athletes and coaches are in good health prior to their travel to Apayao.
- 7. All tournament managers (TMs) shall submit their tournament guidelines, schedule of activities, and other forms for reproduction by the CARAA Secretariat via email (attn: <a href="mailto:pau.depedcar@gmail.com">pau.depedcar@gmail.com</a>) on or before February 20, 2019. Tournament guidelines must be congruent with the latest DepEd policies such as DM 26, s. 2018, DM 64, s. 2018, among others.
- In addition to Paragraph 12 of RM 45, s. 2019, the second and third placers in the Search for the Most Disciplined and Organized Delegation, Best Billeting Center, and the Cleanest, Greenest, and Eco-Friendliest Delegation shall receive plaques of recognition instead of cash prizes.

- 9. Paragraph 18 of RM 45, s. 2019, should also include that management officials, working committee members, and technical/sports officiating officials are entitled to meal allowance in the amount of P400.00 per day with a maximum of 14 days for RSAC Members and a maximum of 10 days for other officials and working committee members.
- 10. Transportation expenses of officiating officials from SDO of origin to Apayao and vice-versa shall be borne by DepEd CAR Regional Office subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 11. No additional or supplemental allowances to cover cost of toiletries, medicines, and other related types of expenses shall be provided to the officiating officials and members of the various management and working committees. Paragraph 19 of RM 45, s. 2019 is hereby rescinded.
