

(10th DIWANG: Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas Competition)
April 3 & 10, 2022 / 1:00-5:00 pm

The Philippine Cultural Education Program (PCEP) of the NCCA envisions to develop strategy to mainstream cultural learning competencies and standards in the formal school curriculum. In 2009 PCEP developed the list of **Essential Knowledge on Philippine Arts, Culture and Heritage for Basic Education Curriculum** through its national cultural mapping project. In 2013, The Sub-Commission on Cultural Education & Dissemination and the PCEP formulated and implemented the **DIWANG: Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas Competition** project that aims to introduce, promote, and practice the cultural icons (Sagisag Kultura) or the Essential Knowledge on Philippine Arts, Culture and Heritage gathered and validated 2010.

This year's **DIWANG: Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas Competition** project is on its 10th year of implementation. Institutionalization of its project components is being developed in partnerships with many established Arts organizations like Department of Education and its Regional Offices, Philippine Madrigal Singers, Linangan sa Imahen, Retorika at Anyo Inc. (LIRA), Barasoain Kalinangan Foundation, Inc., Koro Bulakeno, Inc. and to many other Universities and Institutions.

Balagtasan, as one of the major components of the 10th DIWANG: Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas Competition shall be in partnership with Linangan sa Imahen, Retorika at Anyo Inc. (LIRA). This year's BALAGTASAN project will include a nationwide workshop in conjunction with National Literature Month celebration in April 2022.

- 4. Online registration is free but comes with an obligation. The number of participants is limited, and your registration may result in other attendees missing a slot if the maximum capacity is reached. If you cannot attend to the program for which you have already registered, we kindly ask that you let us know.
- 5. The NCCA-PCEP reserves the right not to issue any Digital Certificate of Appearance or Certificate of Participation to participants who will not finish the workshop as scheduled.
