

RAPID ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES REPORT (RADaR) APP REGISTRATION

TO: Schools Division Superintendents
Chief, School Governance and Operations Division
Project Development Officer (DRRM)

- 1. The deadline for the registration of regional, division and school DRRM coordinators to the Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR) App for the web and mobile devices is on March 30, 2021.
- 2. The DRRMS has issued Memorandum No. DRRMS-111-20-2020-002 in November 2020 to assist Division school coordinators in the registration process. However, status of registration for CAR as of date is still at 76%. (Data enclosed).
- 3. A meeting shall be conducted on March 16, 2021 (9:00 a.m.) for all DRRM Project Development Officers for updates on the Application as well as provide assistance to schools divisions having problems in the registration process.
