



Subject : **DRAFTING OF THE REGIONAL IPED-CAR ROAD MAP FOR CY 2016-2021 AND ASSEMBLY OF REGIONAL IPED COUNCIL OF ELDERS**

Date : April 26, 2016

1. In support to Republic Act No. 10533, the Enhanced Basic Education Program and the IPed provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region will conduct a two (2) day **Regional Training-Workshop on the Drafting of the IPed-CAR Road Map for CY 2016 to 2021**. Said activity will be conducted on May 5-6, 2016 at the NEAP-R Conference Hall, DepEd-CAR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
2. The training- workshop aims to:
 - a. review the existing Regional IPed-CAR Road Map
 - b. draft the Regional IPed-CAR Road Map for CY 2016 to 2021
 - c. sustain advocacy on the Indigenous Peoples Education through the Regional IPed-CAR Road Map
 - d. organize the new set of regional IPed Council of Elders for 2016- 2018

5. Food and accommodation will be charged to IPED funds while, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds subject to auditing rules and regulations. First meal will be dinner of May 4 and last meal will be dinner of May 6, 2016. Lodging of participants will be at the NEAP-R Dormitory for the Council of Elders and CID Chiefs while the old dormitory will be used for the IPED Focal Persons.
6. Travel expenses incurred by the Council of Elders will be charged to the Regional IPED Funds provided that transportation receipts will be submitted to the Regional IPED focal person/Alternate upon arrival for the processing of reimbursement. An honorarium of two thousand and two hundred fifty pesos only (2,250.00) will be given to each Council of Elders for the two days participation.
7. It is further advised that Council of Elders shall convene on May 5, 2016 to discuss by-laws and next steps of the Council.
