



The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) hereby issues this Advisory on the School-Based Deworming Program.

The resumption of the School-Based Deworming Program is hereby advised pending the signing of the Joint Administrative Order (JAO) on Health Services between and among the Departments of Education, Health and Interior and Local Government

While awaiting the approval of the JAO on Health Services, the following Interim Guidelines for Implementation shall be observed to ensure the safety and

- a. Schools will coordinate with local health units to ensure adequate technical support and the provision of deworming medicines;
- b. Written consent from parents or guardians must be obtained before administering deworming medicines;
- c. All personnel involved must adhere to prescribed health and safety protocols;
- d. Conduct of orientation sessions for school staff, parents, and learners to address concerns and provide accurate information;
- e. School Heads are required to monitor and promptly report any adverse reactions to deworming medicines to local health units for immediate action;
