Mechanics:

- 1. Entries should follow the theme, "Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children".
- 2. All entries/paintings shall be on illustration board (15x20 inches), using either oil pastel or crayon.
- 3. The contest is open to all public and private elementary students.
- 4. There are two (2) categories:

Category A: Grades 1-3.

Category B. Grades 4-6.

- ** Two (2) students may collaborate and work together on one (1) entry if they belong to the same school and grade level.
- 5. Each Schools Division Office (SDO) should submit one (1) entry for each category to the DepEd CAR- CLMD on or before April 28, 2023 for final judging.
- 6. Winning entries will be given certificates of recognition and will represent DepEd CAR for the National Art Contest.
