

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 140.2024

WEARING OF THE PRESCRIBED UNIFORM FOR SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS (SDSs) AND ASSISTANT SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS (ASDSs)

- 1. Republic Act No. 6713 otherwise known as the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standard for Public Officials and Employees and the Civil Service Commission (CSC) Memorandum Circular No. 14, s. 1991 on the Dress Code Prescribed for All Government Officials and Employees, requires all government offices to adopt their respective office uniforms for their officials and employees.
- 2. In connection with the unnumbered Memorandum signed by Undersecretary Michael Wesley T. Poa, dated February 6, 2024, all **SDSs** and **ASDSs** shall regularly wear the prescribed uniform for Third Level Officials from **Monday** to **Thursday**, effective April 1, 2024.
- 3. Said officials shall wear the prescribed uniform in the performance of their functions especially during attendance to official events, meetings, and conferences even if it falls on a Friday.
- 4. This office, through Human Resource Development Division shall monitor the implementation of wearing of the prescribed uniforms.
- 5. All SDSs and ASDSs shall coordinate with office of the Regional Director on the availment of the prescribed uniform's fabric and design.
- For teaching and non-teaching personnel, a separate memorandum will be issued.

7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this Memorandum is highly enjoined.
