- 7. Each participant (Campus Journalists & School Paper Advisers) from both public and private schools included in the division list of winners shall pay a registration fee of **Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00**), which shall be charged against School MOOE/Local/SEF and the School Campus Journalism Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. The registration fee to be collected will be used for the following purposes:
 - a. Certificates for participants/winners of showcases
 - b. Honorarium of invited judges outside DepEd
 - c. Meals and snacks of TWGs and judges during the display of school paper and judging of school paper one (1) week before the conduct of academic festival.
 - d. Transportation and accommodation expenses of Judges
 - e. Trophies for top 5 overall winners of showcase events.
