

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 155.2021

STRENGTHENING SCHOOL-BASED MANAGEMENT (SBM) IN DEPED CAR UNDER THE NEW NORMAL

TO: Assistant Regional Director
Schools Division Superintendents
SDO SBM Coordinators and PSDSs
Elementary and Secondary School Principals
All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act 9155 or the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001 and DepEd Order 83, s. 2021, re: Implementing Guidelines on the Revised School Based Management Framework, Assessment Process and Tool (APAT), and the Regional Memorandum No 278, s. 2019, re: Guidelines on the Utilization of School Based Management Assessment Tool with Contextualized Means of Verification, and the conducted SBM validations in the Cordillera Administrative Region for the past three years, findings warrant a need for strengthening the principles of the school system.
- 2. The webinar therefore reiterates the objectives of the RM 278 as follows:
 - a. To highlight Cordillera learners as center of the SBM practice
 - b. To encompass the diverse realities of learning context defined and uniquely occurring within specific geographic, social, cultural, economic and environmental make-up of the contemporary society
 - c. To enhanced commitment of education stakeholders at all levels to their responsibilities and accountabilities in realizing education outcomes for Cordillera learners
 - d. To promote shared governance between the school and community
 - e. To integrate accreditation into SBM for a seamless assessment of a school system
 - f. To improve the school system's capacity to be on track in achieving the Sustainable Millennium Goas and sustain performance.
- 3. The seminar will make use of the Microsoft Teams for online participants and limited face to face for the Divisions of Baguio City and Benguet. Participants of Baguio and Benguet Division shall be required to strictly stay in-house to adhere to General Community Quarantine Health Protocols. The training will be conducted on April 19-21, 2021 from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. The list of participants and training matrix are attached as Enclosures 1 and 2.
