- 1. The Asian Center of Education Research, and Training for Innovation (ACERT) and International Mind Education Institute (IMEI), will conduct *International Mind Education Specialist Training on Curriculum and Leadership in the 21st Century School Environment: Issues and Challenges from a Global Perspective* on May 2-4, 2025, at the Benguet Sports Complex Gymnasium, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 2. The objectives of the activity are the following:
 - a. equip participants with the knowledge and skills to innovate, calibrate, reinvent, and transform school and curriculum leadership to effectively address the needs of 21st-century classrooms and learners;
 - b. enhance appreciation and understanding of global trends, approaches, and frameworks in school and curriculum leadership in the 21st century;
 - c. enable participants to apply and contextualize innovations, approaches, and strategies in school and curriculum leadership; and
 - d. implement a range of curriculum leadership innovations that foster effective learning environments and motivate learners to take responsibility for their own learning.
- 3. The training is **NEAP-recognized** with Recognition No. PD-2021-0074-1028 and **PRC-accredited**, offering **15 Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units.** School leaders, supervisors, school heads, teaching-related personnel, and teachers may opt to attend this activity, provided that their attendance does not interfere with their regular duties and responsibilities. Participation shall be in accordance with DepEd No. 46, s. 2022 (Omnibus Travel Guidelines for All Personnel of the Department of Education).
- 4. A registration of PhP 3,500.00 per participant shall be collected to cover cost of meals for 2 days (including 2 lunches and 4 snacks), training expenses, speaker fees, materials and certificates. The use of DepEd funds is subject to the approval of the appropriate authorities and contingent upon fund availability, adhering to usual budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
