SEARCH FOR BRIGADA ESKWELA BEST IMPLEMENTING SCHOOLS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2016-2017

- To give recognition to public and secondary schools with exemplary accomplishments from their participation in the weeklong Brigada Eskwela activity, the Search for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools is conducted every school year.
- To effectively implement the selection process in the Search for Brigada Eskwela Best 2. Implementing Schools for School Year 2016-2017, this Office issues the enclosed criteria in the selection of Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools.
- The Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools are categorized into three: (a) Small 3. School Category; (b) Big School Category; and (c) Exceptional School Category. For each category, two schools shall be recognized, one for elementary level and one for secondary level.
- There shall be six (6) entries per schools division: two (2) for small school category 4. with 499 and below enrollees, two (2) for big school category with 500 and above enrollees and two (2) for exceptional category which is small or big that exceeded most of the indicators in the criteria per DepED Memorandum No. 36, s. 2012. Each category will have one (1) entry for elementary level and one (1) for secondary level. The deadline for submission of all entries C/o Education Support Services Division (ESSD) this Office will be on or before July 25, 2016.
- The timeline of Brigada Eskwela activities and the selection criteria on the Search for the Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools shall be followed strictly by all concerned.
- Monitoring/evaluation/validation of all entries shall be conducted on August 1-10, 6. 2016 by the Regional Monitoring Team.
