REGIONAL ONLINE CONTEST IN ENGLISH AND FILIPINO INTERPRETATIVE READING cum PROJECT READ TO LEAD

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents All Schools Division Offices All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region (DepEd-CAR) through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the Regional Online Contest in English and Filipino Interpretative Reading cum Project Read to Lead on June, 2022.
- 2. The objectives of this activity are to:
 - a. provide an opportunity for Grades 7 and 8 learners to demonstrate their verbal proficiency through interpretative reading; and
 - b. increase learner's willingness to communicate their thoughts and feelings.
- 3. SDOs shall conduct a Division-wide Online Interpretative Reading contest following the mechanics stipulated in paragraph 5. First Place winners for each required grade level in English and Filipino shall be the entry for the regional level online contest. Each SDO shall submit only two (2) entries or contestants, distributed through the table below:

- 5. Please be guided by the Contest Mechanics specified below.
 - a. There shall be one selected piece for each English and Filipino during the contest attached on enclosures 1 & 2 of the memorandum. Each entry is composed of seven (7) members only.
 - b. Interpretative Reading should last for 3 to 5 minutes including the entrance and exit. Do NOT memorize the piece, instead the contestants provide the source material in a presentable and creative big book style where they will read the piece.
 - c. Contestants must be in school uniform. No other props and costume should be used in reading; therefore, digital and musical instruments sound effects will not be allowed.
 - d. Acting out the piece is not necessary. The readers should be able to portray all characters and their emotions through variation of voice.
 - e. Entries will be submitted through a video. Videos should have a minimum resolution of 720p (16:9) to optimal 1080p (16:9) and may be saved in .vmw,.mov,.mp4, or .mpg file formats before submitting through the online google form through this link: https://tinyurl.com/R2LEng5andFil6
 - f. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

CRITERIA	PERCENTAGE
Projection of Characters-The readers are able to portray all characters and 100% of their emotions in all parts of the story or piece.	25%
Voice Quality-The readers use proper volume, tone variation, pacing, and timing to show expression and feelings of the characters.	25%
Pronunciation-The readers pronounce all the sounds and words clearly, properly in the entire story or piece.	20%
Connection between reader/s and audience,(may include eye contact,& facial expression),level of confidence	20%
Time Management-Delivery is not to exceed for 5 minutes	10%
TOTAL	100%

- 6. All contest entries must be submitted online on or before June 10, 2022 until 4:30 o'clock in the afternoon. Late submission of entries will not be considered.
- 7. All participating learners shall receive cash prizes with corresponding amounts based on their ranks: First Prize = Php 3,000.00, Second Prize = Php 2,500.00, Third Prize = Php 2,000.00 and Consolation Prize = Php 1, 500.00 each for 4th to 8th Placers.
- 8. To assist the team in judging the Interpretative Reading contest, the RO personnel are requested.
