IMPLEMENTATION OF BRIGADA KALINISAN AND DENGUE PREVENTION CAMPAIGN

Date:

July 18, 2016

- 1. To respond to the increasing threat from dengue, all schools/offices will conduct activities/plans on prevention and control against dengue in order to protect the school populace and the community.
- 2. The dengue mosquito bites mainly during day time hours. They breed in containers near and inside our schools, homes and throughout our communities. Therefore, every individual has a key role in keeping the school surroundings clean to fight against dengue year round.
- 3. The following are suggested activities to be done regionwide to ensure school/office surroundings "larvae-free":
 - a. Information, Education and Campaign on the key messages of dengue prevention and control.
 - b. Distribution of posters and leaflets on Dengue Prevention to encourage everyone participate in taking action in dengue prevention.
 - c. Destroy mosquito breeding sites through the following:
 - 1. Cover all water containers tightly and turn it upside down other containers which can accumulate water when not in use.
 - 2. Change the water in flower vases once a week.
 - 3. Disposal of all used tin cans and other useless containers
 - 4. Water canals must be cleaned at all times.
 - 5. Dispose garbage properly and remove rubbish around school premises
 - 6. Regular cleaning of spaces under the tables, chairs and cabinets in the classrooms/offices
- 4. It is requested that the Health and Nutrition personnel will coordinate with the Department of Health, Regional Office and other Non-Government Offices for IEC materials and provision of insecticide Treated Nets/Screens for areas with high dengue incidence.
- 5. All Heads of Schools, teachers, non-teaching personnel, pupils and students are likewise instructed to seek early treatment or refer to proper authorities should there be signs and symptoms of dengue will occur and a close monitoring for those individuals affected with dengue.
- 6. A report on the number of dengue cases per school/division shall be included in the monthly accomplishment report and to be submitted to the Health and Nutrition Section, Education Support Services Division, Regional Office, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
