PRIORITIZATION OF SCHOOLS FOR HAZARD SUSCEPTIBILITY ASSESSMENT AND SUBMISSION OF DIVISION CONTINGENCY/EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS

TO: Schools Division Superintendents PDO II (DRRM)

- 1. The conduct of the regional PDNA for Typhoon Ompong reflected the need for all government schools to be assessed by the Mines and Geo-sciences Bureau-Cordillera Administrative Region (MGB-CAR). This assessment will identify the schools that are within or adjacent to geological hazards and will be the basis for the proper programs and interventions to be extended to the schools.
- 2. To prioritize schools for assessment, DRRM coordinators are instructed to submit the list of schools needing immediate assessment by MGB-CAR on or before July 19, 2019 in the attached format. For those schools already assessed by the said agency, a copy of the assessment shall be submitted to the Regional Office, Attention: DRRM Coordinator.
- 3. DRRM Coordinators are requested to coordinate with their division engineers as to the prioritization of the schools.
- 4. Further, in preparation for the typhoon season, schools divisions are requested to submit their contingency plans and/or emergency response plans to the regional office on or before July 17, 2019.
