CONSTITUTION AND RECONSTITUTION OF THE DIVISION

CHILD PROTECTION COUNCIL (DCPC)

- 1. In relation to the Consultation among DepEd CAR key persons on child protection concerns such as child abuse, bullying, CAR, and CICL (Regional Memorandum No. 110 s. 2016) conducted on April 29, 2016 where one of the recommendations raised was the reconstitution of Division Child Protection Committee for the division offices with established DCPC and constitution of DCPC for division offices without DCPC vet.
- 2. The composition of the Division Child Protection Council is agreed to be as follows:

a. The Officers

- Schools Division Superintendent as Chairperson
- Assistant Schools Division Superintendent as Co-Chairperson
- Representative per Sector as Vice Chairpersons selected by the members of each sector (Teacher's Organization, NAPSHII, PESFA, Student Council, PTA)

b. The Regular Members

- Legal Officer
- Division Office Focal Person for Child Protection

c. Honorary Members

Provincial / City personnel in charge of the Child Protection Programs

d. Secretariat

To be designated by the Schools Division Superintendent

- 3. The Representative per sector will have a term of (two) 2 School Years. In case of retirement, resignation, termination or expiration of term of office before the end of the two (2) School Year term, the new member, officer, or OIC shall serve the unexpired term.
- 4. The main function of the Division Child Protection Council is to recommend and support policies, programs, projects and activities on child protection, as well as ensure its monitoring and evaluation.
- 5. The Council en banc shall have a regular meeting at least twice in a School Year, and the Officers may have additional special meetings as deemed necessary;
- 6. The Division Offices are directed to encourage the involvement of the Provincial/City Child Protection Committee. Thus, an invitation letter may be sent to the Provincial LGU or City LGU concerned.
- 7. All SDOs should submit the lists of its DCPC members and Division Trainors for Child Protection including their contact numbers not later than August 19, 2016.
- 8. For immediate dissemination and compliance.
