- -----1. In compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 461, series 1994 entitled Declaring the First Week of September Every Year as the National Crime Prevention Week, the Department of Education joins the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) and other government agencies in observing the 22nd National Crime Prevention Week.
- 2. With the theme, "Hawak Kamay Tungo sa Kapayapaan at Kaunlaran," this activity aims to generate community awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of crime prevention and foster interest and participation of the general public.
- 3. In this regard, the schools division offices, and public and private schools are encouraged to support said observance and undertake related activities such as the following:
 - a. Integration of the celebration in the different subject areas;
 - b. Hoisting of streamers or banners depicting this year's theme and logo;
 - c. Conduct of a drug awareness forum/crime prevention forum for parents and students in coordination with your local Philippine National Police (PNP) or Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) or other related local government instrumentalities; and
 - d. Organizing of activities like art contests, poster-making and slogan-making contests, and other related contests in line with the theme.
- 4. These proposed activities can be scheduled within the month of September. A comprehensive completion report to be prepared by the Division Social Mobilization Unit shall be submitted on or before September 30, 2016 to the Office of the Regional Director or e-mail at car@deped.gov.ph or pau.depedcar@gmail.com.
- 5. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activities for the said celebration shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules.
