



PARTICIPATION TO THE ASIA-PACIFIC GoIT FACILITATOR ONLINE TRAINING FOR SCIENCE AND MATH TEACHERS

- 1. This refers to the attached letter of Mr. Patrick Jay Veril, Corporate Social Responsibility Manager of Tata Consultancy Services, Philippines, offering partnership with DepEd-CAR in their Digital Innovation Education program named "goIT".
- 2. "goIT" is a student engagement digital innovation program which envisions to strengthen communities today by empowering their digital innovators of tomorrow.
- 3. The program aims to spark curiosity and demystify what computer science and information technology are; meet industry experts; provide safe space to learn design thinking; and build 21st century skills.
- 4. This partnership intends to provide a three-day training to identified Grade 10 students of schools offering Science, Technology, and Engineering (STE) programs in each of the 8 Divisions. The students must be enrolled this SY 2020-2021. They must have stable internet connectivity and a laptop to be able to participate efficiently in the program.

- 6. Enclosure 1 includes the expected number of student participants per identified school and the planned schedule of student training per Division.
- 7. Names of students per school following the given template in Enclosure 2, must be sent through email at clmd.depedcan@gmail.com on or before September 4, 2020. It is requested that SDOs and Schools will ensure an equal number of male and female student participants.
- 8. To immediately check the response of students to this program, a pilot run shall be conducted on September 23 to 25 to about 31 grade 10 students of the Cordillera Regional Science High School, Division of Benguet.
- 9. To help facilitate the training for the students, teacher-facilitators shall be provided with a 12-hour training to provide them with strategies in facilitating the modules for the students and in cascading the program with fellow teachers. The Regional Office Supervisors were included so they could provide technical assistance and monitor the successful implementation of the program. SDO Kalinga has not identified a school offering STE, however the identified teachers are included in this training for professional development and with the expectation that after this activity, the trained teachers shall facilitate opening STE classes in the Secondary Schools in the Division.
- 10. Online teacher training shall commence on August 18 from 9:00 to 11:00 in the morning. Subsequent schedules will be on August 25, September 1 and 8, 2020. Relative to this, the following teachers are recommended:
