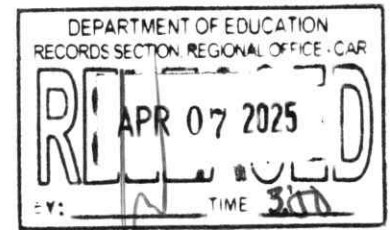

**REGIONAL CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM (CGP) CURRICULUM EXITS  
TRACKING SYSTEM for SCHOOL YEAR (S.Y.) 2024-2025 AND  
CONDUCT LOCALIZED CAREER EXPO**

1. In line with the data gathering for the Curriculum Exits of Senior High School (SHS) graduates the Curriculum and Learning Management Division and Education Support Service Division-Youth Formation will spearhead the Curriculum Exits Tracking System (CETS) for SY 2024-2025.
2. In this regard all Division Youth Formation Coordinators (DYFCs), Guidance Counselors, Guidance Designates, Grade 12 Section Advisers with the assistance from the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) Officers and their respective Teacher Advisers are requested to inform SHS Graduates for S.Y 2024-2025 to complete the Curriculum Exits Tracking System via the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/CETS-SY2024-2025>. The system was officially opens last February 26, 2025.
3. Furthermore, all secondary schools in coordination with the Division Offices are encouraged to submit reports on Localized Career Expo (LCEs) conducted which may include career guidance, career fairs, and similar activities that provide learners with career guidance and opportunities. The event should highlight the four (4) curriculum exits: higher education, employment and middle -level skills development. All Division Offices are requested to Submit a consolidated After - Activity Report, which should include photo and video documentation of the LCEs as Means of Verification (MOVs). These reports must be submitted to the email of the BLSS-YFD no later that April 15, 2025 and will feature during the National Career Expo (NCEX) 2025.
