

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 258.2021

PREPARATION OF ENHANCED MECHANISMS FOR DISTANCE LEARNING DELIVERY, SY 2021-2022

TO: OIC-Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents All Schools Division Offices All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) and ensuring the continuity of learning in education amid the COVID-19 pandemic, the Regional Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) encourages the application of a Learning Management System to be delivered online or offline for School Year 2021-2022.
- 2. To further define the modalities, Online LMS would require the use of electricity, strong internet connection, appropriate gadgets, and digitization of quality assured RO-authorized Self-learning modules with the inclusion of canned versions of DepED TV video episodes as content materials. Offline LMS would require the use of electricity, receivers within the allowable range, appropriate gadgets, and digitization of quality assured RO-authorized Self-learning modules with the inclusion of canned versions of DepED TV video episodes as content materials.
- 3. As part of the planned mechanisms for the next School Year, DepED-CAR shall be procuring tablets from the CO-downloaded BE-LCP funds for the provision of learning resources. Procured tablets shall be used as learning resource support for the provision of digitized SLMs, canned versions of DepED TV video episodes, and learning guides relevant to the implementation of the online or offline LMS.
- 4. Relative to the aforementioned statements, SDOs are requested to identify and validate potential schools that will implement either the online or offline LMS, with enrolled learners to be recipients of the tablets.
- 5. SDOs shall recommend one school for the elementary and one school for the secondary level. Priority school beneficiaries shall be those listed under the last mile category, with primary consideration of the following indicators. In cases where the last mile schools cannot comply with the stated indicators, SDOs may recommend other schools that can comply.

- 6. The following indicators may be used as basis in the identification of potential school-beneficiaries:
 - a. School has electricity
 - b. Teacher implementers are ICT-literate and practitioners
 - c. Learners to be provided tablets must belong to only one class. If in the elementary level, they must be enrolled in Grades 3, 5, or 6. If in the secondary level, learners must be enrolled in any of these grade levels: Grades 7, 8, 9, 10, or 11.
 - d. Parents strongly support and are willing to assist the children for online or offline LMS
- 7. SDOs are requested to complete the attached template in **Enclosure 1** and send the accomplished report through email address **clmd.depedcar@gmail.com** not later than **July 15, 2021.**
- 8. Attached in **Enclosure 2** is the matrix of activities relative to the implementation of this mechanism, for your guidance and compliance.
