

1. develop a comprehensive collaborative expertise learning resource package that equips educators with tools and strategies for effective collaboration designed to ensure that LAC sessions are structured, focused, and aligned with the specific professional development needs of teachers working in special curricular programs;
2. provide educators with practical approaches to engage in collaborative professional development grounded on foundational principles and purpose of the collaborative expertise to strengthen understanding of its theoretical framework underpinning LAC, as well as clarifying the various roles and responsibilities of DepEd offices in its successful implementation;
3. promote a culture of collaboration across schools, empowering teachers to share knowledge and learn from one another; and
4. align collaborative practices with DepEd's goals for improving quality, equity, and efficiency in basic education.

In this regard, the Regional Offices, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), are requested to identify eight (8) Education Program Supervisors/ School Heads/ Special Curricular Programs Focal Persons to participate in the series of activities (*see Enclosure 1 on Distribution of Participants*).
