Subject: 28th NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH CELEBRATION



- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, issued on September 20, 1990, the month of October of every year is declared as the National Statistics Month (NSM).
- 2. The objective of the statistics quiz is to instill awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics among our teachers and students.
- 3. The observance and the month-long celebration of the 28th National Statistics Month this October, 2017 has for its overall theme, "Facts and Figures for the Future: Statistics for Evidence-Based Decisions Towards Ambisyon Natin 2040" ("Estaditika para sa Hinaharap: Ambag sa Pagtupad ng Ambisyon Natin 2014"). In line with the celebration, this Office will conduct the Regional Statistics Quiz for Senior High School students on October 27, 2017 at the DepEd-CAR Regional Office, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 4. Each Schools Division shall conduct a Division Statistics Quiz to come up with their winners as participants to the Regional Statistics Quiz. Collaboration with the Philippine Statistics Authority Provincial/City Offices is highly recommended.
- 5. Participants shall be the top one (1) winner and one (1) coach for each Schools Division.
- 6. Confirmation of participants shall be emailed to essd.depedcar@gmail.com on or before October 23, 2017 following the format below:

- 8. Transportation and other expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

GUIDELINES/MECHANICS OF THE REGIONAL STATISTICS QUIZ

- 1. The contestants are the one (1) top winners from Grades 11 to 12 and a coach in each Schools Division. Each contestant shall bring his/her school ID bearing his/her Learner Registration Number (LRN)
- 2. Substitution is not allowed during the quiz proper.
- 3. No cellphones, tablets, or any other electronic communication devices are allowed during the competition.
- 4. There will be three (3) components in the competition: Easy Round, Average Round and Difficult Round.
- 5. Questions will include general information, basic educational statistics and general statistics.
- 6. Each question will have the following sequence:
- a. The quiz master will read the question projected on the screen twice. A timer will start after the quiz master says "GO".
- b. Each contestant will raise his/her answer card after the quiz master will say "TIME IS UP" until the scores are properly recorded.
- c. The quiz master will announce the correct answer for the questions. The assigned proctors will check each contestant's answer card to determine if their answer is correct or wrong. The proctor will raise a **BLUE** flag for the correct answer and a **RED** flag for a wrong or no answer at all.
- 7. In case of a tie, tie-breaker questions will be given until a winner is determined by the highest number of points. Each tie-breaker question will be given four (4) points.
- 8. Decisions of the Quiz Committee shall be final and non-appealable.

EASY ROUND:

- 1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth two (2) points for each question.
- 2. Each question is timed for ten (10) seconds.
- The scores of each contestant will be totalled and carried over the next round.

MODERATE ROUND:

- 1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth three (3) points for each question.
- 2. Each question is timed for twenty (2) seconds.
- 3. The scores of each contestant will be totalled and carried over the next round.

DIFFICULT ROUND:

- 1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth five (5) points for each question.
- 2. Each question is timed for thirty (30) seconds.
- 3. At the end of the Difficult Round, all scores will be summed up and the top one (1) contestant will be declared as the winner. The contestant with the highest number of points is automatically declared as the champion and the next contestants as runner-ups.
