# General Guidelines on the Conduct of the 2017 Regional Musabaqah Skills Exhibition

- 1. The Skills Exhibition is open to all learners attending ALIVE classes in the Public Schools and ALIVE in ALS and in the Private Madaris/Schools.
- 2. Participants should have registered and complied with the following requirements prior to the activity.
  - Certification as Winner/Regional Memorandum
  - Parent's Consent
  - NSO Birth Certificate
  - Accomplishment Entry Form
  - Form 137
  - Medical Certificate and
  - School ID
- 3. Any participant who fail to comply with the requirements and the qualifications specific to each category shall be qualified.
- 4. Filled out entry form should be submitted at least two weeks before the conduct of the regional Musabaqah Skills Exhibition.
- 5. Winners in each category shall receive cash prize and Certificate of Recognition while the non-winners will receive Certificate of Participation.
- 6. Winning coaches shall receive a Certificate of Recognition and non-winning coaches shall receive Certificate of Participation.
- 7. For the events with judges, the decision of the judges is final.
