CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (CARAA) MEET 2017

- 1. The 2017 Cordillera Administrative Region Athletic Association (CARAA) Meet will be hosted by the City Government of Baguio City and the Department of Education-Baguio City Division on February 6 to 10, 2017 at the Burnham Athletic Bowl, Baguio City.
- 2. The international rules of all the sports events will be applied. However, all ground rules must be presented during the solidarity and must be approved by the Chairperson of the Technical Management Committee.
- 3. Enclosed are the sports events to be played, playing venues, billeting venues, schedule of activities and policies for the guidance of all delegations.
- 4. Service credits will be granted to officiating officials, coaches, chaperons, delegation officials who are on teacher leave basis while Compensatory Time-Off will be granted to officials and other non-teaching personnel for services rendered during Saturdays and Sundays within the duration of the meet subject to civil service rules on service credits and Compensatory Timeoff. The Schools Division Superintendents shall issue special order on service credits/compensatory time-off to the coaches, chaperons, delegation officials and officiating officials in their respective divisions and the Regional Director shall issue special order on compensatory time-off to regional office personnel only.
- 5. Numbers of athletes in athletics will be provided by each delegation.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.

REGIONAL POLICY/GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE CARAA MEET 2017 AND SELECTION OF ATHLETES, COACHES, ASSISTANT COACHES, CHAPERONS, TRAINERS AND TEAM MANAGERS TO THE 2017 PALARONG PAMBANSA

A. CARAA Officiating Officials

- 1. Must be accredited by DepEd, NSAs effective 2016.
- 2. Recommended officiating officials with dual functions (like assigned as team manager, coach and other functions in their delegation) will not be accepted by management.
- 3. No complete attendance during the sports clinic will be replaced and the replacement will come from the host division

B. Selection of Athletes, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers and Team Managers to the Palarong Pambansa

- 1. Selection of Athletes
 - 1.1. Racket Games
 - Champion in Doubles
 - Gold and Silver medalist in Singles
 - 1.2 Athletics/Track and Field
 - Gold Medalists for Individual Events
 - Second Placers
 - Relay Winners
 - 1.3 Swimming
 - Gold Medalist in Individual Events
 - Second Placers
 - Relay
 - 1.4 Combative Events
 - Gold Medalists
 - 1.5. Archery
 - Gold Medalist Individual
 - 1.6 Ball Games
 - Champion Coach and Tournament Manager will select the best athletes based on skills
- 2. Selection of Coaches

First option - Champion Coach based on Medals (gold, silver and bronze)

- in case of tie in no. Of gold, go to silver, then to bronze

Second option - the most number of players

- 2.1. in case the Champion Coach will not come, Co-coach/ Assistant Coach will take over and in case the Co-coach/ Assistant Coach will not come, the 2nd placer Coach will take over
- 2.2. Racket Games:
 - the Coach will come from the team with the most number of selected athletes
 - in case of tie, the champion coach in doubles will be the coach
- 2.3. Chaperons- the chaperon of the of the champion coach
- 3. Team Managers, Assistant Coaches and Trainers the option of management with the permission of SDSs concerned
