

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES FOR THE REGIONAL CORDILLERA MARCH COMPOSITION CONTEST

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents All Divisions All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region (DepEd-CAR) through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the Regional Online Composition of Cordillera March Contest in the celebration of the 35th Cordillera Month with the theme, One Autonomous Cordillera: Ensuring Social Development and Inclusive Growth in the New Normal.
- 2. The contest aims to showcase the talents of teaching and non-teaching personnel through music and appreciate the life, values and cultures of the Cordilleran. The competition is open to all teaching, non-teaching personnel, students as well as PTA. Only entries officially endorsed by the Schools Division offices (SDOs) shall be considered as official entries.
- 4. Each SDO is allowed to submit two (2) entries. Deadline of submission is on July 25, 2022. All endorsed entries shall be sent through email address at edgar.vicente@deped.gov.ph. Attached in **enclosure 1** is the Mechanics & Criteria for Judging.
- 6. All contestants shall receive certificate of recognition. Awarding of certificates shall be given during the culminating day on July 29, 2022 at the open court, DepED-CAR Regional office, Wangal, la Trinidad, Benguet and be live through DepEd Tayo Cordillera Facebook page.

MECHANICS AND CRITERIA IN JUDGING THE CORDILLERA MARCH COMPOSITION CONTEST

Competition Mechanics:

- I. Who are qualified to join?
 - 1. The competition is open to all teaching, non-teaching personnel including students and PTA members of school within the Cordillera Administrative Region.

II. How to join?

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- 1. The musical composition must be an original work of the contestant.
- 2. The genre should be in the marching tempo (2/4 beat)
- 3. The entry must be reflective and appreciative of the life, enduring values, and cultural heritage of the Cordillera people.
- 4. Lyrics of the song must be in English.
- 5. One or a combination of a musical instruments may be used as accompaniment.
- 6. The song must not exceed 3 minutes inclusive intro and outro.
- 7. The entries must be recorded and shall be submitted in".mp3" format with vocal and accompaniment together with the transcribed musical piece/score with lyrics and chords.
- 8. The song entry must not have been used or have been commercially released.
- 9. Words with registered trademarks/brand names, explicit and offensive lyrics are strictly prohibited.
- 10. All entries, once submitted cannot be modified or altered already
- 11. Deadline of submission of entries shall be on July 25, 2022.
- 12. All entries shall be judged according to the set of criteria for judging by experts in Music, Composition Writing and Musical Arrangements from the academe and HEI partners and practitioners.
