2016 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC)

November 4, 2016

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1, Rule IX of Republic Act 7079, also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Department of Education - Cordillera Administrative Region (DepEd - CAR) announces the conduct of the 2016 Regional Schools Press Conference with the theme, "Strengthening Freedom of Information Through Campus Journalism", to be held at Benguet National High School, La Trinidad, Benguet on December 8-11, 2016.

#### 2. The conference aims to:

- a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through varied journalistic endeavors and approaches;
- b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
- c. provide a venue for enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
- d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
- e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
- 3. The conference activities shall include the following in two levels: elementary and secondary, and of two media: English and Filipino:
  - a. Group Contests;
  - b. Individual Contests;
  - c. Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting Contests;
  - d. Collaborative Desktop Publishing (CDP) Contests;
  - e. Online Publishing Contest (Exhibition for secondary level );
  - f. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting Contests (for secondary level);
  - g. Concurrent Session
  - h. Awarding of the Winners and Outstanding School Paper Advisers (SPAs) and Campus Journalists (CJs), among others.
- 4. The deadline for the submission of the top 7 winners in each section per level/medium from each division to the Regional Office will be due on or before December 5, 2016 and the Top 5 Winners per category in the Individual contests including the following reports listed below.
  - List of Script Writing and Radio Broadcasting Contestants
  - b. List of Collaborative Publishing Contestants
  - Supporting documents including the division rating sheets of candidates for the Top 2 Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists

- d. Top 7 Winners per section in the Group Contests accompanied by a List of division School Paper entries
- 5. The members of the Group Contest Display Committee are requested to be in the Regional Office on December 6, 2016 at 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Please refer to Enclosure No. 2 for the members of the Regional Technical Working Group (RTWG).
- 6. A registration fee of Five Hundred Fifty Pesos (₱550.00) shall be collected from each participant to be paid in cash to the host division, charged against local funds/journalism funds or any available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies/rules and regulations. This will cover honoraria, transportation and meals of judges, trophies, kits, supplies, and other operational expenses. Meals and transportation of the participants shall be taken care of by their own division.
- 7. The main participants to this conference are the Top 5 Division Winners and Coaches in each of the eight (8) categories of the Individual Contests, team winners and coaches of the Group Contests; Radio Script Writing & Broadcasting contest, TV Script Writing & Broadcasting contest (Secondary level only), Collaborative Desktop Publishing Contest in the two levels and of the two media, totaling to three thousand and two hundred sixteen (3,216) participants. The breakdown of participants per Division is as follows:
  - 8 individual contest categories x 5 winners x 2 levels x 2 media =160
  - 7 contestants (Radio Scriptwriting & Broadcasting) x 2 levels x 2 media = 28
  - 7 contestants (TV Scriptwriting & Broadcasting Secondary Level) x 2 media = 14
  - 7 contestants (Collaborative Publishing) x 2 levels x 2 media

= 28

- Coaches/School Paper Advisers = 172 TOTAL 3,216
- 8. Students in Elementary and Secondary (both Junior and Senior High Schools) levels are eligible to join the contests.
- 9. The School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists are advised to pay their membership fees in the amount of sixty pesos (₱60.00) and thirty pesos (₱30.00) respectively to the Division Treasurers of their respective associations.
- 10. The Implementation Guidelines for the Conduct of the Group Contests, Individual Contests, Collaborative Desktop Publishing Contest, Radio Script Writing & Broadcasting Contest, TV Script Writing & Broadcasting Contest, and Online Publishing are attached in Enclosure No. 1.
- 11. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 12. Participants are expected to be at the venue on December 8, 2016 in the afternoon for the Registration.
- 13. Top 5 Winners in the NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE shall be given cash incentives on the following:
  - a. Individual Writing Contests: first-₱2,500; second-₱2,000; third-₱1,500; fourth-₱1,000; fifth-₱700 (for both coaches and students)
  - b.Group Writing Contests: first-₱7,000 for students and ₱3,000 for coach; second-₱5,500 for students and ₱2,500 for coach; third-₱4,000 for students and ₱2,000 for coach; fourth-₱2,500 for students and ₱1,500 for coach; fifth-₱2,000 for students and ₱1,000 for coach
