ADDENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 323, s. 2018 (Conduct of the 2018 Regional Indigenous Peoples Month Celebration)

- 1. Relative to the conduct of the 2018 Regional IP Month Celebration, please be reminded that each Division will have to prepare an intermission presentation good for 8 to 10 minutes only. Each presentation must depict the unique culture of the Division. The presentations will be showcased during the opening program on October 18.
- 2. Moreover, skill demonstrations of dances, songs, and chants will be done at the plenary hall. Mechanics for the skill demonstration will be as follows:
 - a. Skill demonstrators or moderators are expected from the Divisions of Abra, Apayao, Baguio City, Benguet, Ifugao, Mountain Province, and Kalinga and Tabuk City.
 - b. Skill demonstrations must last for 45 minutes only per skill. Within the allotted time limit, demonstrators or moderators must be guided by the following questions:

Dance, Day 1	Song, Day 2	Chant, Day 2
What is the name of the dance?	What is the title or name of the song?	What are the chants being portrayed?
When is it portrayed?	When is it sang?	When is it chanted?
What are the steps? (Explain meaning or significance of the steps)	Why is it sang?	Why is it chanted?
Demonstration while participants follow	What is the meaning of the lyrics?	What is the meaning of the chant lyrics?

- 3. All participants are expected to arrive before 5:00 PM of October 17 in time for the Welcome Program.
- 4. For Day 1, October 18, all participants are expected to be in their respective Ethnic
- 5. Exact venue for lodging and Welcome Program will be informed through SMS (text message).
- 6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
