

## Enclosure 1. Guide Questions for the presentation on the Assessment of the First 5 Weeks of Quarter 1 Learning Resources

- What percentage of the following SLMs were distributed to the learners?
   CO initiated? Locally-developed (specify if Regional, Division, School initiated)?
- 2. What common errors were identified in the CO initiated SLMs? Locally developed SLMs? What specific actions were taken as regards these errors?
- 3. What is the mechanism implemented in the whole Division for distribution and retrieval of SLMs? Is it weekly? Every 2 weeks? Monthly? Others?
- 4. Generally, what is the percentage of module accomplishment of learners within the given period? (Are all learners able to accomplish given modules within the allotted period?)
- 5. Is there a tracking mechanism implemented to check learners' activities within the class week?
- 6. Are parents providing feedback to teachers? Are teachers also providing feedback to learners after accomplished modules have been submitted?
- 7. Aside from modular learning delivery, what other modalities of learning delivery were implemented? (audio, video, radio, TV, online, etc).
- 8. Did the teachers conduct learning assessment (summative and performance) as per DO 31, s. 2020? How are interventions being conducted for learners in need of more assistance?
- 9. Did the schools seek help from volunteer teachers or Learning Support Aides for instruction?
- 10. What are your ways forward? Suggestions/Interventions to improve delivery of learning for Quarter 2?
