

ONLINE TRAINING ON TV-BASED INSTRUCTION AS LEARNING ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION DELIVERY (TI-LABID)

- 1. In response to the new normal education amidst this pandemic crisis and having been committed to widening the access to quality education, DepEd CAR supports the **TV-Based Instruction**, being one of the set-ups of learning delivery under the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP).
- 2. Considering the above-mentioned, the Human Resource Development Division will conduct a training on TV Based Instruction particularly in Scriptwriting and Video Filming Techniques in preparing sound, interactive and professional educational videos for TV-Based Instruction for teachers in the Elementary and Secondary Schools in the region on December 7, 8 and 9, 2020 (Phase 1) and January 11, 12, 13 and 14, 2021 (Phase 2) via zoom platform. Link shall be announced later.
- 3 The general objective of this training is to equip teachers in the basic education with the necessary skills in crafting educational scripts and applying video filming techniques while using technology creatively and innovatively in creating their videos for instruction. Specifically, the training aims to:
  - A. Increase teaching resources and supplementary tools for teachers in teaching in the blended learning set up of the current school year amidst the pandemic through interactive and video-rich educational contents.
  - B. Promote television and TV-Based Instruction as a teaching strategy and as a platform in the elementary and secondary levels to address students' learning needs in distance education.
