- 3. Travel of participants shall be on official business. The registration of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (3,500.00) shall be charged to the Division/School Maintenance and other Operating Expenses, local or regional funds, or other sources of funds, including the participants' travel expenses and incidental expenses, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4. DepEd-CAR counterpart of Five Thousand Pesos (P 5,000.00) will be downloaded to the division/school offices concerned.
- 5. All coaches and contestants are required to bring the following documents:

## a. For Contestants

- Certification by the school head that the participants is a bonafide student enrolled in Public (General or Technical Vocational) or private high schools during the School Year 2016-2017.
- The school principal/school head shall certify that students are enrolled in the field of specialization where they are competing and participating.
- Photocopied school ID
- From 137, signed by the school registrar/school head

## b. For Coaches

- Certification from the principal that the teacher is a bonafide staff of the school being represented.
- Certification from the principal of the teacher's designation as the coach of the participant.
- Service Record and School ID
- National Certification of the Teacher for contest skills with NC qualification.
- Copy of DepEd Memorandum 209 s. 2016, re: 2017 NATIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS for your reference.

- 6. Division offices can allow additional participants to the 2017 National Technolympics to assist their participants and observe the conduct of the National Technolympics. However, their expenses will be charged to the division, school funds and other local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
- 7. Check-in time will be in the afternoon of January 22,2017 with snacks as the first meal and check-out will be in the morning of January 26,2017 with lunch as the last meal.
