- 1. Possesses an approved Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in Linguistics, English Language, TESOL or Education)
- 2. TOEFL: 550 paper-based; 213 computer-based; 79 internet-based;
- 3. GCE O Level English: B3 and above;
- 4. GCE A Level General Paper: C6 and above;
- 5. Cambridge Advanced English (CAE): C and above;
- 6. SPM 1119 English: B and above (GPK/ PNG 3.00 and above)/ Kepujian Tinggi and above
- 7. STPM General Paper/ English Literature: B- and above (GCPA/HGMP 2.67 and above)
- 8. Malaysian University English Test (MUET): B4 and above
- 9. CU TEP with a score of 65 (equivalent to IELTS 6.5) and above
- 10. APTIS (all four macro skills): B2 and above
- 11. Filipino Citizen;
- 12. Must be 50 years old and below:
- 13. At least five (5) years government service in DepEd;
- 14. Must be computer literate and have access to stable internet connection;
- 15. Able to utilize course learning and share to other colleagues upon completion;
- 16. Must hold a permanent appointment;
- 17. Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case;
- 18. Must have a college degree and/ or sufficient demonstrated ability; and experience related/ relevant to the course applied for;
