- 1. The 2018 Regional Technolympics will be conducted on December 6-8, 2018 at Baguio City High School-Main, Harrison Road, Baguio City adopting the National Festival of Talents theme "Celebrating Diversity through the Performance of Talents and Skills for Sustainable Inclusive Education"
- 2. The activity aims to showcase the competencies acquired by learners in their school or learning centers providing wider learning space for others to bench mark better practices.

- 4. Arrival and Registration of participants will be in the afternoon of December 6, 2018. The solidarity meeting of coaches, officials and members of working committees will be at 4:00 PM onwards the same day. Closing program will be at 11:00 AM on December 8, 2018.
- 5. Costs of materials to be used during contest proper; honorarium and or token for the members of the Board of Judges; Meals and snacks of the members of the working committees; light and water bills; and expenses for decorations, trophies and certificates will be charged to Regional Office Funds downloaded to the host school while Food, Transportation and other incidental expenses incurred by contestants, coaches and trainers from the Schools Division Offices will be charged to any available and allowable Schools Division Office Funds subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Participants are advised to bring their own beddings and other necessary personal effects.
- 7. The complete staff work (CSW) containing other details pertaining to this activity is enclosed in this memorandum.

#### VI. General Guidelines

4,1

A Cales

In addition to the guidelines enumerated in DepEd Memorandum No. 168, s. 2018, the following additional guidelines will be observed:

- 1. Contestants shall be given recess time for their snack and lunch for 20 minutes and 60 minutes respectively.
- 2. All materials to be used during the contest proper will be provided by the host school while tools, equipment and instruments will be provided by the contestants.
- 3. School TVL offering is not a requirement for participation in the contest.
- 4. Participation to the Regional Technolympics is open to all currently enrolled/registered learners with LRN.
- 5. Only DepEd personnel are allowed to coach during contest proper.
- 6. Certifications attesting to the enrolment and LRN of contestants and employment of coaches together with the list of delegation must be submitted by SDOs at the Regional Office on or before December 3, 2018.
- 6. First placers in the Division level competition will represent the SDO in the Regional Level. In the event that for some reason the first placer cannot make it, the second placer should be the alternate not automatically coming from the school or district where the former came from.
- 7. Experts and practitioners from other agencies/institutions shall be invited as Judges.
- 8. Smoking in any form and drinking liquor is strictly prohibited within the school campus,
- 9. Any form of vandalism is strictly prohibited. Any participant caught in the act of doing so will be required to restore/replace damaged part or item or clean and repaint as the case may be.
- 10. All other guidelines provided in DepEd Memorandum 168 s. 2018 shall be adopted as applicable including the contest mechanics, assigning of points, ranking system and others.
