



### 2019 SCIENCE FILM FESTIVAL

#### 2019 SCIENCE FILM FESTIVAL

- 1. In support of the Memorandum of Agreement(MOA) between Goethe Institut-Philippinen and the Department of Education (DepEd), the **2019 Science Film Festival** with the theme: *Humboldt & The Web of Life* shall be conducted from November 5 to December 6, 2019.
- 2. The Festival aims to promote science literacy and enhance awareness of contemporary scientific, technological and environmental issues through the medium of film and television.
- 3. Learners from both public and private secondary schools particularly the Regional Science High Schools (RSHSs), Legislated Science High Schools (LSHSs), Science, Technology and Engineering (STE) implementing schools and Special Science Elementary Schools (SSES) are invited to watch the films.
- 4. The Regional Science Education Program Supervisor shall coordinate the conduct of the 2019 Science Film Festival and shall retrieve the visitor count per school. The Regional Office (RO) shall submit a softcopy in Excel format of the Visitor Count Summary Form through email at joseph.gutierrez@deped.gov.ph on or before **December 7, 2019.** The RO shall also collect the hardcopy of the Visitor Count Summary Form including all the films and submit the same to **Ms. Jocelyn DR Andaya**, Director IV, Bureau of Curriculum Development, 3rd Floor Bonifacio Building, DepEd-Central Office, on or before **December 9, 2019**.
- 5. The opening of the festival will be on **November 5, 2019** at the SM Megamall Cinema, SM Megamall, J Vargas cor. Epifanio de los Santos Ave, Ortigas Center, Mandaluyong, with the screening of the film Arnote's Ark. Participants to the opening of the festival are students from selected schools in the Schools Divisions of Pasig and Mandaluyong City listed in Enclosure No. 4, as well as the Science Education Supervisors of the National Capital Region and the Schools Divisions of Pasig and Mandaluyong City
- 6. Participation of schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. The activity is also subject to no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546. An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Projects or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities.

- 7. Expenses relative to the transportation of students shall be charged to the schools Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rulesa and regulations.
- 8. Operational costs, including communications, shall be charged against the 2019 BCD Funds. On the other hand, other expenses relative to the conduct of the Festival in participating schools shall be charged to the schools MOOE.

## MECHANICS FOR THE SCIENCE FILM FESTIVAL SCREENING

The following shall be observed before, during and after the activity:

## 1. Preparation:

- The venue/room must be equipped with screen and video player (DVD player or PC/laptop).
- The science films are in DVD format.
- The teacher/guide to facilitate the viewing activities are advised to watch the films in advance and prepare guide questions that may help stimulate students' interest and better understanding of the film.

The copies of the film will be forwarded to the Regional Offices (RO). ROs will forward the films to the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and SDOs will forward the films to specific schools as indicated in Enclosure No. 3 of this DM.

### 2. Reception and Work Instructions

a. The teacher/guide shall provide background information about the Science Film Festival and explain briefly the film to be screened. The synopses can be used for this purpose.

## 3. Screening of the Film

The students/viewers shall be advised to watch the film completely and without interruption.

## 4. Processing (Pre- or Post-Screening)

The guide questions prepared before the screening may be used to reinforce the information from the films and strengthen the students' understanding of concepts and theme of the film.

The guide questions below may be used as samples:

- a. Which part of the film did you feel most engage with? Why?
- b. What science lessons can be learned from the film? Elaborate your answer.
- c. Other than the science concepts presented in the film, what interesting facts or ideas does the movie bring to mind?
- d. As a grade school/high school student, what concepts presented in the film are relevant in addressing issues concerning the role of the youth in the contemporary times?

#### 5. Visitor Count Form

- a. The teacher/guide shall prepare the Visitor Count Form and submit the same to the Regional Science Education Program Supervisor. The form to be used is provided in Enclosure No. 4.
- 6. The Regional Offices (ROs) shall collate the Visitor Count Fom and prepare the Summary Form as provided in paragraph 4 of this DM.
