



REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 410.2021

BUILDING PARTNERSHIP AND LINKAGES THROUGH BRIGADA PAGBASA INNOVATION FAIR

TO: OIC- Assistant Regional Director Chiefs/Heads of Functional Divisions/Units/Sections Schools Division Superintendents All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to DM 267, s. 2021 or the Guidelines on the Utilization of Program Support Funds for Building Partnership and Linkages Program for Fiscal Year 2021, the Regional Office through the Education Support Services Division in collaboration with the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, issues this guidance to SDOs on the conduct of the *Brigada Pagbasa* Innovation Fair dubbed as "Building Partnership and Linkages through *Brigada Pagbasa* Innovation Fair". Culmination of this activity shall be done on a blended strategy on November 26, 2021.
- 2. The implementation of programs, activities, and projects (PAPs) at the Department of Education (DepEd) was severely affected by the situation brought about by the pandemic. Due to this, challenges were encountered by the teachers and partners in the field in the delivery of lessons. One that was greatly affected was equipping the learners with reading skills to make them proficient and independent readers in their grade level.
- 3. The Pagbasa, as part of Brigada Eskwela is an after-school reading program that envisions bringing together education partners and experts to help all learners read and become functionally literate. This will serve as a platform to synergize efforts and resources to address education related challenges especially on reading and literacy. It will also create opportunities for all stakeholders to contribute possible solutions to the current gaps in the country's education system.
- 4. This Office urges Schools Division Offices (SDO's) to facilitate the conduct of *Brigada Pagbasa* Innovation Fair which encourages the implementation of reading remediation/intervention for learners who were assessed to be readers under frustration level. Further, this would be an avenue to strengthen partnership and linkages with stakeholders especially that they play crucial and vital roles in the implementation of DepEd's programs and activities.
- 5. The goal of this *Brigada Pagbasa* Innovation Fair is to highlight interventions done at the school level to address reading and comprehension issues encountered among learners enrolled in any of the key stages, including ALS or SPED.

- 6. Each SDO is expected to have complete story entries for all key stages including ALS and SPED. To complete the entries, SDOs may have 6 participating schools to represent the following:
 - a. Key Stage 1: Kindergarten to Grade 3
 - b. Key Stage 2: Grades 4 to 6
 - c. Key Stage 3: Grades 7 to 10
 - d. Key Stage 4: Grades 11 to 12
 - e. ALS
 - f. SPED
- 7. Final submission of AVP entries shall be on or before November 16, 2021 through this link: tinyurl.com/*Brigada Pagbasa* Fair.
- 8. Each participating school shall present their *Pagbasa* innovation stories to highlight interventions they have implemented to address reading and comprehension concerns among their learners, enrolled SY 2021 to 2022. This shall be presented through an AVP considering suggested format and following the requirements in presentation:
 - 8.1. Presentation shall contain this story and follow this format:
 - Remote steps undertaken to identify learners under frustration reading level/s;
 - Specific reading issue or concern to be addressed;
 - Steps undertaken to provide intervention despite the current health crisis;
 - Stakeholders invited to provide support in the planned reading intervention;
 - Concrete actions implemented to provide intervention;
 - Effect/s on the learner or improvements observed;
 - Lessons learned; realizations after the intervention done;
 - Steps to sustain the intervention/s implemented.
- 8.2. Since each entry shall be submitted through a video, the following requirements shall have been observed:
 - o written consent from learner's parents that the video shall be published for educational purposes only.
 - o visuals of learners must be put on blurry mode.
- 9. Since each story entry is unique, considering the various reading issues or concerns and the interventions adapted for each type of issue, the story entries shall not be judged based on the intervention done or improvement achieved, but on the video presentation and comprehensiveness of the innovation story, thus:
 - a. Category 1: Best Division Brigada Pagbasa Implementer SDO Category
 - b. Category 2: Best Brigada Pagbasa Innovation Story School Category
 - c. Category 3: Best Brigada Pagbasa Partnership Engagement School
 - d. Category 4: Best Video Presentation School Category

- 10. Criteria for judging divided into 4 categories are presented in Enclosure 1 and Timeline of Activities in Enclosure 2.
- 11. There shall be top three winners for each category that will receive Certificates of Recognition and *Pagbasa* Learning Kits. Certificates of Participation and Learning Kits shall be given to non-winners to recognize efforts to provide intervention on reading issues and concerns.
- 12. To provide technical assistance and to monitor the conduct of this activity, the following Regional Personnel are assigned to wit:
