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
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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This agreement is entered into by and between:

The **Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region** (DepEd-CAR), with office address at Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet, hereinafter represented by MAY B. ECLAR, Ph.D., CESO V, Officer-In-Charge, Office of the Regional Director, hereinafter referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**;

and

The **Technical** Skills Development **Authority-Cordillera** Administrative Region (TESDA-CAR) with office address at Magsaysay, Loakan Road, Baguio City hereinafter represented by EFREN F. PIÑOL, Regional Director, hereinafter referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**;

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the Department of Education's thrust is to ensure access and quality basic education for all Filipino learners through effective implementation of the programs, activities and projects;

Whereas, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) is the government agency tasked to manage and supervise technical education and skills development (TESD) in the Philippines and sets direction, promulgates relevant standards, and implements programs geared towards a quality-assured and inclusive technical education and skills development and certification system;

Whereas, in line with the goal of the K to 12 Basic Education Program for the teachers to be equipped and competent in their respective fields of specialization, DepEd-CAR will conduct the Trainer's Methodology (TM) Assessment for Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) Teachers and ALS Teachers;

Whereas, TESDA-CAR and DepEd-CAR agree to collaborate on the implementation of the Trainers Methodology I for TLE and ALS Teachers identified by DepEd-CAR;

Whereas, the training aims to provide TLE teachers and ALS teachers with an additional credential that will certify their competence to effectively teach in their field of specialization;

Whereas, the participants must satisfactorily pass the assessment and certification process of TESDA after the conduct of the training;

Whereas, the funds for the purpose shall be charged to 2016 TechVoc Continuing Funds to be downloaded to the regional offices then to the division offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and stipulations herein below set forth, the parties, the PARTIES HAVE AGREED AND **HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**



I. ROLES OF the PARTIES:

FIRST PARTY

- 1. Identify and recommend qualified trainees from the pool of TLE Teachers and ALS implementers which is found in "Annex A",
- 2. Provide technical assistance to the recommended participants and service provider within the implementation of the program;
- 3. Ensure the attendance and completion of the training on TM by the TLE and ALS Teachers;
- 4. Download the funds to the Schools Division Offices in the amount of **ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND SEVENHUNDRED FIFTY** (**Php 134,750.00**) **ONLY** for each Schools Division to defray the necessary expenses for four (4) trainees (**P 33,687.50 per trainee**);

SECOND PARTY

- 1. Facilitate the provision of training on TM I through its TESDA Technology Institutions (TTIs) and the competency assessment of TM I graduates;
- 2. Issue the Training Methodology Certificate to graduates who pass the competency assessment; and
- 3. Prepare Enrolment and Termination Reports for submission to the TESDA Central Office and for inclusion in the online monitoring system of TESDA.

II. ACCOUNTABILITY:

The agreement shall be implemented as agreed upon in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated herein. In case of non-compliance or violation of the terms and conditions of this agreement, the parties may resolve the issues primarily through available alternative dispute resolutions, subject to other available remedies.

III. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

In case one or both Parties decide to terminate this Agreement/Program, request in writing should be given to the other Party at least fifteen (15) working days before the proposed date of termination. Concurrence of both Parties is necessary.

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IV.EFFECTIVITY

This MOA shall take effect upon the signing of the parties and shall be valid and binding until the completion of its purpose/s or unless earlier terminated by the parties.
