

- The International Cooperation Office (ICO) is mandated to provide recommendations on the creation of the international cooperation agenda for basic education. Part of the development of the international agenda project is to conduct need assessments and gap analysis. The ICO together with the highly technical consultants will conduct an Online Survey for the Bureau and Service Offices, Regional Offices, and Schools.
- 2. The departments' international agenda for basic education envisions to set a unified and holistic direction in promoting the Philippine basic education agenda among the ministries of education in the region and beyond. This will further ensure definitive participation and cooperation among multilateral, regional-multilateral institutions and nongovernment organizations to increase the department's engagements and support in achieving the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- 3. The International Agenda for Basic Education project aims for the:
 - Institutionalization of agreed areas of cooperation

The agreed areas of cooperation will be anchored on the department's priorities and aspirations, harmonize with the national government agenda as well as with the global trends in education. Further, the output of the research agenda will introduce the current and future

trends of cooperation in education that could be integrated into the department's education agenda.

 Facilitation and strengthening relationships resulting in increased engagements to benefit the department's stakeholders

The agenda will further provide a straightforward list of education strategies that will convey an advanced vision of the department's education agenda in the international arena.

- 4. The needs assessment and gap analysis will assess the in-depth appreciation of the concept of internationalization as well as the level of readiness of the actors/stakeholders. It will further assess the ongoing internationalization activities and partnerships as well as the best practices among stakeholders. Hence, the needs assessment and gap analysis will put forward the plans, targets, and reforms that the department may adopt relevant to the objective of pursuing internationalization of the basic education system and the direction that it is likely to take place.
