REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 423.2022

ESSENTIAL GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents All Divisions Others concerned

- 1. This Office issues this memorandum to reiterate essential guidelines that must be in place for School Year 2022-2023.
 - a. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022, titled "School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2022-2023," the following shall be adopted:
 - i. From August 22, 2022 to October 31, 2022, schools may implement 5-days of in-person classes, blended learning, or full distance learning.
 - ii. Starting November 2, 2022, all schools shall have transitioned to 5 days in-person classes, except for those that are implementing Alternative Delivery Modes as provided for in DO 21, s. 2019 and DO 1, s. 2022.
 - iii. The time allotment for in-person class hours shall be based on Annex 1 (for elementary) and Annex 2 (for secondary education) of DO 21, s. 2019.
 - iv. The Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) shall continue to apply for SY 2022-2023.
 - v. Classroom assessment shall follow DO 8, s. 2015.
 - vi. The number of school days shall be dedicated to academics and related co-curricular activities. The conduct of extra-curricular activities shall be strictly prohibited.
 - b. In line with the different learning delivery modalities being implemented for School Year 2022-2023, the following shall be considered by teachers when preparing their lesson plans:
