



MURAL MAKING PROGRAM

GUIDELINES:

- Students, parents and teachers are invited to paint the school wall
- Theme: "Bright Smiles lead to Brighter Futures"

OBJECTIVES:

To instill the value and importance of Oral Health among students through art
To promote collaboration and school spirit among students and faculty of participating schools To
create awareness on Oral Health importance in the community
ROLES:

- > Regional Office: Communicate thru a memo to all Division office attention to ESSD and SDS
- > ESSD: Endorse letter to SGOD and monitor program implementation
- > Division Office: SDS to send a memo to all schools and collate all entries from participating schools
- > Division Dentist In-Charge: To facilitate implementation of the program and collate all entries
- > School Principal: To collaborate students, teachers and parents to paint the school wall

MURAL GUIDELINES:

Concept: Mural should revolve around the concept of "Bright Smiles lead to Brighter Futures" **Location**: Mural should be in front of the school for maximum visibility. As much as possible, near the school's main gate is most preferred.

Size: Mural should have a minimum height of 10ft and width of 12ft.

Design: Mural should contain the following:

- i. Colgate smile logo (minimum 1ft x 1ft
- ii. BSBF logo (minimum 1ft x 1ft)
- iii. Red and white predominant colors

Materials: Mural can be made of paint or other materials appropriate for exterior use (e.g. mosaic, tile). Best if materials are durable and long-lasting.

- This program aims to recognize school learners who have persevered and remained optimistic despite all the challenges thrown their way. Selected public school learners will be given financial assistance and will become role models for other learners to practice the virtues of hard work, perseverance and resilience.
- This program also aims to help equip the "support system" (i.e. teachers and schools) of the Filipino public-school learners with necessary tools to allow them to continue teaching and encouraging school learners to take care of themselves, especially oral health, and to help develop children's inner strength. Suggested Theme: Tibay ng Ngiti, Tibay ng Loob Criteria for school learner nominations:
 - 1. School learner must be enrolled in Grades 4 to 6 in a public school in the Philippines for SY 2019-20.
 - 2. School learner must maintain a minimum grade point average of 80% and have no grade lower than 80% from last school year (SY 2018-19).
 - 3. School learner must have good conduct (no record of detention or suspension) and need to good moral character certificate by the school principal.
 - 4. Student's family must be enrolled in the government's *Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program* or 4Ps.

Entry details:

- Essay can be in either English or Filipino
- Each entry must be one page only (max legal size 8.5" x 14")
- Entry must be typewritten, maximum of 500 words
- Entry must include a current photo of the nominated student and his/her teacher, taken
 in the school where the child is enrolled
- All Entries will be submitted to DepEd
