

## ADVOCACY CUM ORIENTATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS DISTRICT SUPERVISORS ON SPED/INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents All Schools Division Offices All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Education Cordillera Administrative Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will be conducting an **Advocacy cum Orientation of Public Schools District Supervisors on SPED/Inclusive Education** on November 28-30, 2022 at the Strawberry Hotel, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 2. The purposes of this activity are the following:
  - a. Capacitate the participants on SPED/Inclusive Education implementation;
  - b. Orient the participants on the characteristics of learners with manifestations in the different categories;
  - c. Provide guidance on appropriate accommodation of learners with manifestations in an inclusive setting; and
  - d. Develop confidence as PSDSs conduct M&E/TA to school heads and teachers.
- 3. Participants for this activity are the Public Schools District Supervisors preferably those who attended the Upskilling of Supervisors on SPED/Inclusive Education in Subic, Olongapo City, and/or with a big heart to serve and understand the nature of learners with disabilities.

- 9. The school heads, head teachers or department heads shall handle the class of the teachers as contingency measure to ensure continuity of learning.
- 10. Participants shall be granted COCs/CTOs subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules and regulations by their respective Schools Division Offices and Regional Office as the case may be.
- 11. Accommodation and Meals for three (3) days shall be charged to the downloaded SPED Program Support Fund while travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to School MOOE/Local Funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
