

2024 NATIONAL TECHVOC DAY CELEBRATION

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisor-CID All Others Concerned

- 1. In reference to DM-CT-2024-279, DepEd-Cordillera Administrative Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) in coordination with Schools Division of Baguio City, will be holding an activity in celebration to the **2024 National TechVoc Day.** The activity will be held at Pines City National High School-Senior High School on **August 29**, **2024** with a **theme:** "Tech-Voc Tungo sa Pag-unlad at Pagbangon: Angking Talino at Kakayahan, Linangin at Isulong".
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. emphasize the importance of technical-vocational education through providing a platform for the exchange of information, updates and sharing of best practices related to technical-vocational education programs; and,
 - b. promote and raise awareness of the various technical vocational education offerings available in schools;

As stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 on Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and in adherence to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024 titled Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024 and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-curricular Activities, classes should not be disrupted.
- 4. In adherence to the above provisions, the activity will be participated by select regional office officials, officials from SDOs Baguio and Benguet, and identified teachers and learners who will showcase their talents and skills.
