- In reference to DM-OUOPS-2024-05-06271, the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) will provide copies of the updated Child Protection Committee (CPC) Functionality Assessment Tool.
- 2. The tool is designed to be more user-friendly and comprehensible, thereby improving the monitoring and evaluation of CPCs, ensuring that they effectively fulfill their roles and responsibilities in protecting learners.
- 3. The following five areas of work represent the broad work areas of a CPC, each with specific sub-indicators:
 - Organization and Coordination; I.
 - a. Establishment or Reorganization of CPC
 - b. Coordination and Mechanism
 - Policies and Guidelines: II.
 - a. Child Protection Policy and Operational Guidelines
 - III. Capacities and Resources;
 - a. Orientation/Capacity Building Activities for the CPC
 - b. Budget Allocation for CPC operations and its financial sustainability
 - Service Delivery; IV.
 - a. Prevention Programs
 - b. Existence of Quick Response System for Child Protection
 - c. Referral System, Case Management, and Monitoring and **Documentation of Cases**
 - d. Proactive Identification and Reporting of VAC Cases (Early detection)
 - Accountability and Performance V.
 - a. Availability and accessibility of statistical report on cases handled
 - b. Child participation in CPC Planning, Implementation, and Evaluation
 - c. CPC Monitoring and Evaluation
- The CPCs are assessed based on these work areas and are given corresponding scores according to the level of functionality: (1) Not Yet in Place; (2)







This has reference to DepEd Memorandum-OUOPS-2024-05-06271 on the Dissemination of the Updated Child Protection Committee (CPC) Functionality Assessment Tool. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012, all public and private elementary and secondary schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee (CPC) to carry out their roles and responsibilities in safeguarding the rights and protection of all learners.

By virtue of DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2021, the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO), formerly known as the Child Protection Unit (CPU), was created to establish mechanisms to fully operationalize, implement, and coordinate programs, projects, and activities, relative to child protection. The LRPO is mandated to ensure the establishment and functionality of the CPCs in schools.


The purpose of the CPC Functionality Assessment Tool Monitoring Sheet is to systematically evaluate and track the functionality and operational capacity of CPCs. This tool ensures that the committee is functioning in accordance with the established guidelines and standards for protecting children's rights and welfare.

By monitoring the work areas such as organizational and coordination mechanisms, policies and guidelines, capacity and resources, service delivery, and accountability and performance, along with their sub-indicators, the monitoring sheet assists in identifying areas for improvement to enhance the CPCs for the overall safety and well-being of all learners.


